

Critical Communication Challenges and Concerns


IN MANUFACTURING




According to the **2020 Workplace Safety Survey**, many employers are not addressing existing communication hurdles to ensure their employees are safe and informed during both emergencies and the day-to-day.

Not all manufacturing employees were aware of their company's plans in the event of an emergency.




Additionally, the most widely-used communication methods for emergencies don't always efficiently notify all employees.




The two most preferred forms of communication among surveyed manufacturing employees were **intercoms** and **mass text messaging**.



Participants largely agreed that their employers prioritized workplace safety.



Manufacturing employees are ready to engage in workplace safety, with **98% of respondents** in this industry saying they would report a workplace safety concern.
