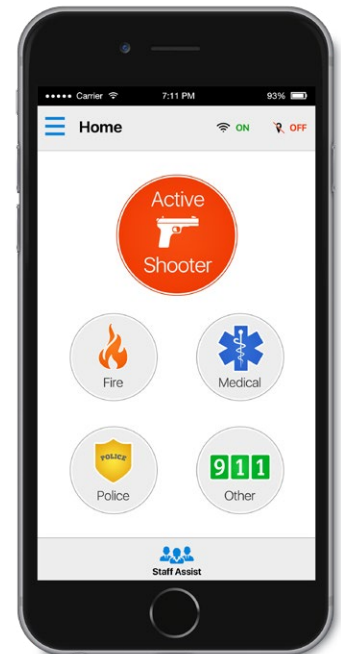


Oklahoma School Safety Initiative

The Oklahoma State Department of Education (OSDE) has partnered with key education and public safety stakeholders across the state, including the Oklahoma 9-1-1 Management Authority, to enhance school safety and security in Oklahoma. OSDE State Superintendent of Public Instruction, Joy Hofmeister, has funded **Rave Panic Button™** for all public K12 districts and brick and mortar charter schools in the state. Rave Panic Button ([view overview video here](#)) is designed to speed emergency response by simultaneously placing a native wireless 9-1-1 call while delivering immediate notification of the nature and location of the emergency to other employees and first responders. Included in this school safety initiative is the option for PSAPs to receive additional information related to a Panic Button activation, as well as the ability to deliver follow-up notifications to any school within their jurisdiction. The license fees for many of these capabilities are also being paid for by OSDE. Any capabilities that may involve additional costs or fees are completely optional (See items listed in red below). There are no mandatory costs or fees for the Oklahoma 9-1-1 PSAPs. This program is optional and is not a mandatory requirement for Oklahoma PSAPs.



It is important to note that if a PSAP elects to not participate in this program, that the schools will still be able to leverage Rave Panic Button for internal notifications and the current 9-1-1 call routing and processing will remain unchanged. The PSAPs that do choose to participate will be provided with additional information about the type of emergency being reported, the location on campus and may have access to details about the school, including floor plans and other critical information. The third option in red below also allows the PSAP to view RapidSOS data on all 9-1-1 calls not just those placed with the panic button.

The table below provides a summary of the options available to your PSAP and technical requirements. Software licenses and assistance for the Rave 911 Suite Basic and Rave Command View is included in the OSDE purchase. **The Rave 911 Suite Standard can be purchased by the individual PSAP for an additional cost and contract.**
