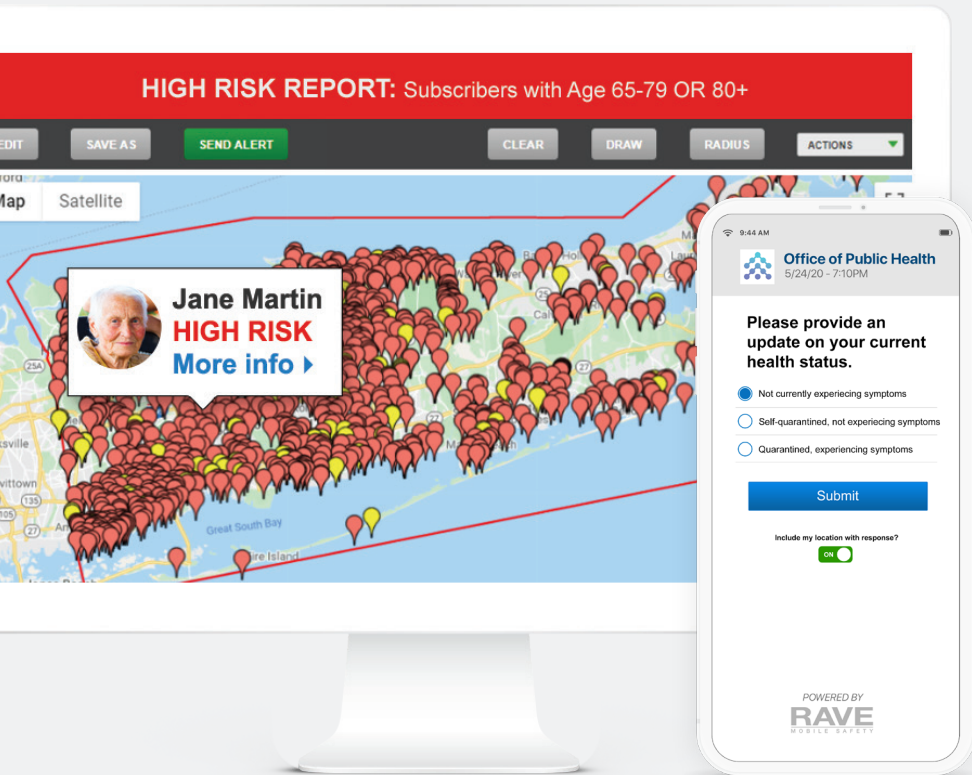

The National Governor's Association (NGA) recently released a 10-point plan called the "**Roadmap to Recovery**" centered around two key components:

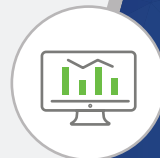
- **Building the Public Health Infrastructure**
- **Creating and Executing a Plan to Gradually Reopen the Economy**

Building the **Public Health Infrastructure**

Complement contact tracing and public health activities with scalable technology-enabled solutions to identify illness clusters or at-risk communities. Let us help you prepare and rapidly mobilize a response for the next phase of the COVID-19 pandemic and support your efforts for any other events to come.



REAL-TIME MONITORING.

Conduct automated wellness and health checks on your community and allow them to provide updates on their quarantine or health status. Residents can opt-in to self-report the information they are comfortable sharing with strong privacy protections. All data is encrypted and collected through a secure web-based application.



HIGH RISK COMMUNITY IDENTIFICATION.

Aid in your strategy around vulnerable populations and essential workers by identifying those at high risk according to CDC guidelines, including individuals over 65 years old or with pre-existing conditions like immune deficiencies, hypertension, and diabetes.



TARGETED COMMUNITY NOTIFICATIONS.

Facilitate rapid isolation for individuals positively identified in contact tracing. Send direct and targeted messages, for example to those that have tested positive for COVID, essential workers, or residents within a certain geographic area with specific information related to their community, such as mobile testing availability.



AGENCY COMMUNICATIONS SUPPORT.

Keep your community informed via text, email and voice calls to provide actionable information such as shelter in place, social distancing, or encourage testing. Clearly view and communicate with high-need areas and offer access to housing, medical care, food, childcare, or other needs.



COORDINATION WITH PUBLIC HEALTH & RESPONSE AGENCIES.

Ask registered residents to identify as a healthcare worker, first responder or other essential worker in contact with the public or find trained responders such as EMTs, paramedics, nurses, physicians and more. **The only platform that gives you the ability to engage stakeholders across 9-1-1, first responders and emergency management.**

Creating and Executing a Plan to **Gradually Reopen the Economy**

Targeting daily communications with the public, assigning clear responsibility for next steps, and building public-private partnerships will be key to reopen effectively.



TRUSTED SOURCE OF COMMUNICATION.

Drive targeted communications to your residents and encourage them to take action to better protect themselves and the community.



IMPROVED RESPONSE.

Collect and leverage data to drive additional polling and assessments. Provide this critical health data to 9-1-1, first responders and public health to stay ahead of outbreaks, act quickly on new threats, and know the health of each caller.



CONTINUOUS ASSESSMENT.

Ensure the right technologies and data tools are in place to provide services, monitor isolation activities, and measure outcomes. Communicate new and safe treatments or prioritize vaccines for those that need them most.



CONSISTENT MESSAGING.

Provide updates on recovery progress, define clear guidelines, and emphasize ongoing safety measures to ensure everyone stays safe as the economy reopens.
