## THE AREAS OF SCHOOL SAFETY CONCERN

School leaders across 13,000 U.S. school districts are planning for many measures. Keeping **over 56 million students** safe is one of the most challenging priorities for school leaders. The health and wellness concerns for some students are complex and long-lasting. Meanwhile, adverse events may last only minutes.



10 million-20 million children and adolescents in the U.S. have some form of chronic illness or disability that may last from three months to a lifetime.

**8 in 10** children ages 3–17 with depression receive treatment.





83% of targeted school attacks from 2008 to 2017 were over in **five minutes or less**.

## THE IMPACT OF COVID-19

School leaders will also have to continue to navigate the coronavirus. Experts are wrestling with the pandemic's toll on students, though some concerns have already appeared.
